

Outdoor Learning

In the first half term, our outdoor learning will be based around our science topic of plants. In the second half term, our outdoor learning will link with art and looking at printing.

Maths- I am a mathematician

Year 1 will be learning about multiplication, division and fractions (finding a half or a quarter of a shape or quantity)
Year 2 will be revising addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also be learning about fractions and measurement.

English – I am a reader and a writer

We will be enjoying a variety of books, stories and poems about dinosaurs; both real and imaginary. We will be creating information pages and writing letters. One of our key texts will be 'Dear Dinosaur'.

Summer 2026

The Land Before Time! Who stomps, chomps and roars?

Computing

Year 1 will insert background, characters and text to label their work and make a comic. They will also have an opportunity to create music using a computer. Year 2 will be introduced to data handling and they will create an E-book about dinosaurs.

History – I am a historian

We will be finding out about the history of dinosaurs and learning about Mary Anning.

PE

We will be practising for Sports Day, developing our skills when playing invasion games and taking part in multi-skills activities with Mr Lewis.

DT – I am a designer

The children will be making a moving dinosaur picture using levers and slides.

Art - I am an artist

We will be learning the technique of printing and will use fossils and footprints as a starting point for our work.

Science – I am a scientist

Our scientific learning will be about plants. The class will learn what plants need in order to grow and stay healthy. We will also revise our learning about animals and habitats.

Geography – I am a geographer

We will be learning about human and physical geography. We will be learning about Lyme Regis.

Music – I am a musician

Our music unit this term is called 'sounds'.

PSHE – life learning

Our learning will focus on well-being, fitness and healthy eating. The class will learn that different things that can go into/onto a person's body can make them feel good or bad such as medicines, alcohol and tobacco. In Relationship and Sex Education, the children will learn the correct scientific names for body parts. Year 2 will learn about the biological differences between male and female animals and children.

In RE our two enquiry questions are...

Are Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur important to Jewish children?
