Maths- I am a mathematician

We will be looking at place value and addition and subtraction. Year one and two are taught maths separately.

English – I am a reader and a writer

We will be writing for a range of purposes. Some of the texts we will read includes, Toby and the Great fire of London, Amelia Earhart, Emma Jane's Aeroplane, The Great Explorer? and Journey. In the first half term we will focus our writing around our history unit and our understanding of vehicles and transport. After half term, our English learning will focus on journeys.

How do we travel from place to place?

Geography – I am a geographer

We will be looking at maps and linking this to our learning about vehicles.

PE
